The Schmallenberg Virus (By Ilse Vink)

Late last year a new virus, named for the town in which it first appeared, was *identified in Europe. The Schmallenberg* virus affects cattle, sheep, and goats, causing minor or no symptoms in adult animals, but causing birth defects and stillborn deaths in their newborn offspring. The virus is so far thought to be transmitted by biting insects. Hundreds of farms across Europe are reporting losses in their ruminant population.

The CFIA (Canadian Food Inspection Agency) has therefore imposed new import regulations against bovine, bison, water *buffalo, sheep and goat semen, as well as to* bovine and bison embryos, hoping to protect Canadian livestock herds from this devastating new illness.

Europe's veterinary community is currently working to eradicate, or manage, the virus in its countries' cattle, sheep, and goat herds.
