- 5. Please note that (original) registration papers must be handed in **before** the sale in order to sell your animals.
- 6. All bull's must be DNA'd includingt purebred.
- 7. Deadline for consignment is August 1st, 2010.



Hamburg Soup/Stew

- 1 lb. (500g) extra lean ground beef
- 1 onion chopped
- 2 carrots sliced
- 2 celery stalks sliced
- 1 28oz. can diced tomatoes (or partial can, if you're not crazy about tomatoes)
- 1 can tomato soup
- 2 cans consommé soup
- 2 cans water
- 3/4 cup pearl barley

Sauté beef and onions. Drain off fat. Add carrots and celery. Sauté a bit more. Put in large pot and add remaining ingredients. Bring to a boil. Turn down heat and simmer for 2 hours.

OR

Brown the meat, drain, and then put all the other ingredients (uncooked) into a crockpot, add the meat, stir. Cook on low for about 4-6 hours. Yum!
